



Logitek Application Note Restricted Accounts In Windows XP

Facilities whose IT policies require that most personnel be assigned to the USERS group in WindowsXP may find that the restricted security rights of the USERS group prevents Logitek applications from running properly, as the applications need to write both to the directory where they are launched as well as to the system registry.

To overcome these restrictions, the System Administrator must grant full control permissions to the USERS group when accessing Logitek specific folders and registry keys.

The steps below should be performed by user logged in to Windows with Administrator priveleges.

How to assign Security Rights to Restricted Users in WindowsXP

1. Open Windows Explorer
2. Open the C: drive
3. right-click on the C:\Logitek3.6 folder and select SHARING AND SECURITY
4. click on the SECURITY tab
5. select the USERS group
6. check the FULL CONTROL box in the permissions list
7. click APPLY and then OK
8. run REGEDIT
9. navigate to the HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE/SOFTWARE/LOGITEK Key
10. right-click on the folder icon and selected PERMISSIONS
11. select the USERS group
12. check the FULL CONTROL box in the permissions list
13. click APPLY and OK
